Position Title: Physician – Primary Care (MD or DO)

Reports to Chief Executive Office / Chief Medical Officer

REACH Medical / Project provides low-threshold, harm reduction-oriented primary care in a multi-disciplinary, integrated practice to further the REACH Mission of ensuring health equity to all who typically face stigma in the current healthcare system. Successful applicants will be able to demonstrate based on experience and/or an aspirational commitment, their professional alignment with the tenets of harm reduction, health equity, and providing care to underserved populations.

Position Goals and Role:

The Primary Care Physician of REACH Medical/Project provides clinical services to REACH patients and clinical supervision of Advanced Practice Primary Care Providers and Internal Medicine Residents doing primary care on site in alignment with the REACH mission and in accordance with our accreditation (s) and federal and state guidelines both as a provider and member of the REACH team.

Responsibilities:

- Provide primary care services to patients including oversight for Advanced Practice Providers and / or Internal Medicine Residents.
- Provide full time primary care and Medication Assisted Treatment for the treatment of opioid use disorder.
- Deliver high quality, collaborative, accessible, primary care to patients both in person and virtually.
- Attend organizational training / staff meetings.
- Work collaboratively with:
 - REACH contracted and employed medical / behavioral health providers / all program staff.
- Abide by high standards of care for:

- Delivering care that is truly equitable and stigma-free.
- Abiding by REACH clinical guidelines.
- Medical billing related timely and quality documentation.
- High quality, timely, electronic medical record documentation.
- Provide care as needed at the regional Syringe Exchange Program Health Hub.
- Share after- hours call.

Qualifications:

- Currently licensed in New York State as a Physician with primary care (e.g. Internal and/or Family Medicine) experience.
- Interest and commitment to providing care to the underserved through Harm Reduction and Low Threshold Care.
- Experience in a team-based care model of service delivery.
- Exceptional communication skills and organization skills to work with external agencies and the REACH Management Team.
